Originally built by Mike Haywood but now owned and enhanced by BMRC member Chris Towers
A Typical Colonel Stephens Type small station/goods yard, portrayed in O gauge

Despite being O scale it uses OO rail to portray its light railway nature.

The location was original Southern but now portrays a much wider area and times.

Control is conventional with points and signals being worked by solenoid motors.

Stock is mostly kit built although a couple of Ixion ready to run locos have been purchased.
Buildings are constructed from foam board with various cladding materials.

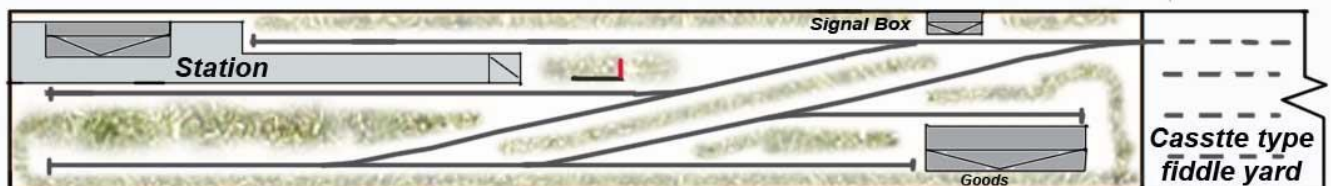


Hire this layout for your show

Needs – Provision of a large car or small van + fuel as well as lunch and vast quantities of tea for 3 operators. Accommodation with breakfast required if over approx 1 hours travelling. Requires a table for stock along with 2 sockets, Consumption 400W (mainly lighting)

Dimensions are 14ft 3" by 2ft (4.3m by 0.6m) plus 3ft (900mm) behind for operator space
