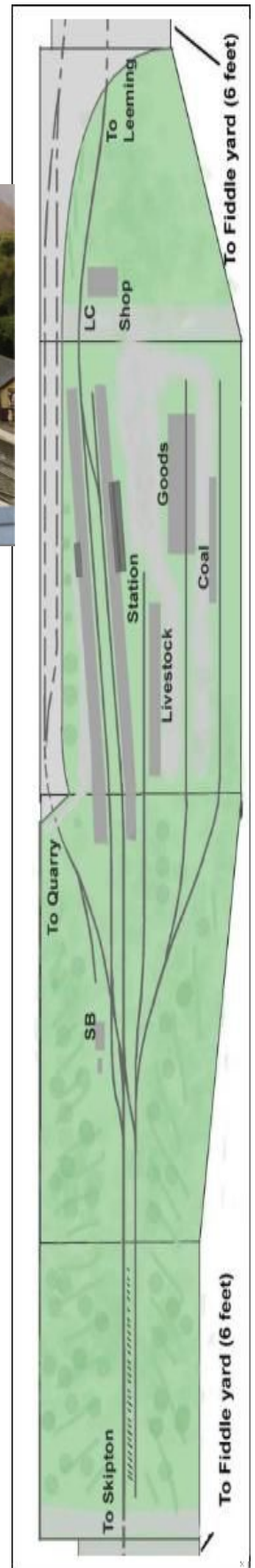
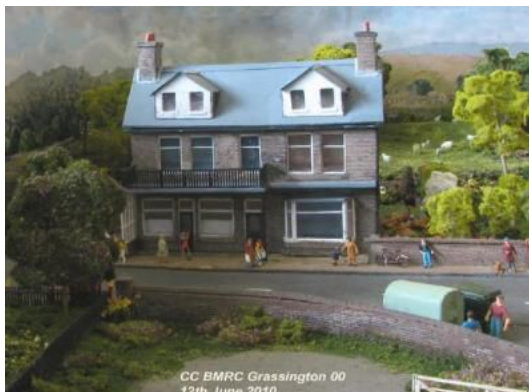
A quality Layout from Bradford Model Railway Club

Grassington is a layout based on Grassington and Threshfield the terminal station of the Midland railway branch from Skipton It featured in the December 2011 Issue of **Hornby Magazine**.

When the Midland built the Grassington Branch in 1900 from Emsay Junction, their intention was to carry on right through to Wensleydale to link the North Eastern's cross country line from Garsdale on the Settle-Carlisle to Northallerton. However, the branch never got further than Grassington (that is until



Bradford M.R.C. got involved!), - so here is the Grassington Branch Extension as it might have been in the late 40's to early 60's. It is interesting that even though it was a terminal station it was constructed as a through station with 2 platforms and a trailing rather than facing crossover for the loco run-round.
