



Victoria Road (00 Gauge 4 mm=1ft)

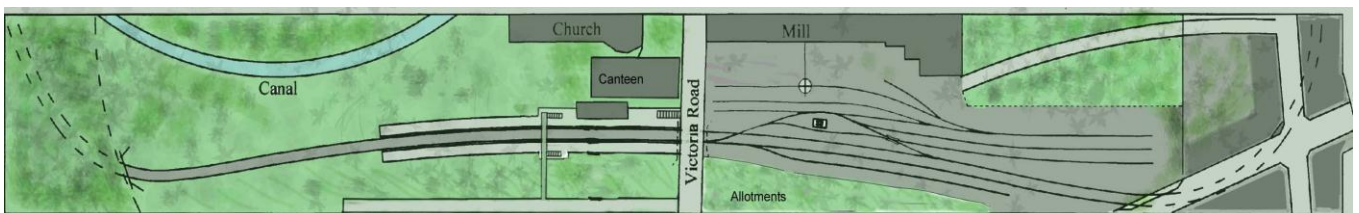
An award winning layout from Bradford Model Railway Club

Victoria Road. is based on the ex Midland line north of Shipley heading towards the famous Settle & Carlisle. It was featured in the December 2008 issue of **Hornby Magazine**. Many of the buildings and scenery are modelled on those at Saltaire but because of the constraints of size it has had to be 'shrunk' somewhat so we have named it after the road on the bridge adjacent to the station. Local people will no doubt recognise many of the features and hopefully get the atmosphere of the area. The period modelled is 50's 60's however Victoria Road can be caught up in a time warp where the stock can appear from other periods which allows club members to run whatever they prefer.



Hire this layout for your show. Requires expenses for Van, fuel, insurance, lunch and vast quantities of tea for 2-3 operators. Also 2 sockets consumption 200W (mainly lighting). Insurance value £5000 excluding stock. Also required is a table for stock

Additionally for distances of over approx. 60 miles or 1hr travelling Bed and Breakfast accommodation with English breakfast will be required.
